- ❖ The reporting time of the examination is 10:30 a.m. No candidate will be allowed in the examination hall after 11 a.m.
- ❖ No electronic gadget is allowed inside the examination hall.
- ❖ The test will be of MCQ Type & duration is of one hour. Syllabus and Question papers will be selectively decided by the faculty members based on NEET or JEE Main pattern.
- ❖ The teacher-guardian interaction session will be from 11:15 a.m. onwards.
- ❖ Result of the exam will be announced by 1 p.m. & scholarship program will be conducted thereafter.
- ❖ The validity of the scholarship benefits will be till 30/06/2019.
